**Music (MUS I):** Introduces students to the history and theory of music. The class is broken into 4 main areas: early musical forms, classical music, American jazz and rock and roll. The course will explore the relationship between music, cultures and social movements.

**Entrepreneurship (ENT I):** This semester long class will introduce students to entrepreneurship by allowing them to create a business. The class involves mentorship from local business owners, volunteer opportunities at local businesses and a pitch competition at the end of the class.

**Journalism (JOUR I):** Students will study principles of print and online journalism as they develop writing techniques and responsible reporting. The class will simulate a newsroom and produce a publication to be distributed to students and faculty.

**Theater (THE I):** Students will learn how to perform and act along with the major areas of theater including production and stage design. The students will also acquire behind the scenes experience through the production of 1 play.
